One proposed forestry lot was visited during the tour. The lot was located just off of the Barre Falls Dam.

The lot covers 25 acres and consists of a 50/50 split between oaks and pines. Stops were made along the tour at 2 potential landing sites. The area is in a Natural Heritage & Endangered Species Program (NHESP) estimated habitat polygon. NHESP will give recommendations on how to best avoid impacting the sensitive species.
