

Senior Parking Pass Online Instructions

The Department of Conservation and Recreation has partnered with YODEL to offer Senior Parking Passes online. Patrons may purchase passes at http://MassDCRparks.YODELpass.com/ using a desktop computer or any web-enabled device.

To be eligible for a Senior Parking Pass:

- Patrons must be 62 years of age or older.
- Patrons must be a Massachusetts resident.

Required documents:

- Massachusetts driver's license
- If you do not have a MA driver's license, you can upload a copy of a Government issued ID AND proof of Massachusetts residency (i.e., vehicle registration or utility bill). Please note, out of state driver's licenses are not accepted.

Applicants are required to create an account, and upload proof of age and MA residency as noted above to purchase a Senior Parking Pass. DCR staff will verify your eligibility based on the submitted documents. Once your eligibility is confirmed, you will receive an email notifying you to proceed with your order. Upon receipt of payment, DCR will mail your parking pass to the address on file. Please allow 3-7 weeks to receive your pass.

Purchase Instructions:

- 1. Visit: http://MassDCRparks.YODELpass.com/
- 2. Review the Terms and Conditions
- 3. <u>Click Login</u> on the upper right-hand corner of the webpage or click <u>Login to Proceed</u> after selecting Senior Passes on the home page.
- 4. Create an account or login if you have an existing MassDCR/YODEL account.
- 5. Select Senior Passes Each account can purchase up to 3 passes (i.e., for 3 different individual seniors).
- Upload the required documents (MA Driver's license, or Government issued ID PLUS proof of MA residency)

To upload documents:

 Scan and save the required document/s to your computer then upload to the website.

OR

 Use a smartphone to take of a photo of the document/s, email the file to yourself, then save the file to your desktop. Upload the file to the <u>MassDCR/YODEL</u> website. If you are submitting a government ID and utility bill, please upload as one file.

- 7. Check your email for status notifications. You may receive an approval, a request for resubmission of documents, or a rejection email depending on the status of your application. Follow the instructions as noted in the email. If you do not receive email notifications, check your junk/spam folder.
- 8. Log into the <u>MassDCR/YODEL</u> website to submit payment once you receive an approval email. Mass DCR accepts Discover, Mastercard, and Visa.

An email confirmation will be sent to the email address on file after purchase. Please do not delete the email until you receive your parking pass.

How to use your Senior Parking Pass

Passes must be displayed at all times when visiting a DCR paid-parking facility. Hang your parking pass on the rearview mirror of your vehicle. You may receive a parking citation if your parking pass is not properly displayed.
