

Home Care Program

The Home Care Program provides care management, care coordination, advocacy, education, and in-home and community support services for adults aged 60+, people with disabilities, and people under age 60 living with Alzheimer's disease or related dementia.

Program participants are connected to a trained, professional Care Manager who coordinates the participant's care.

Examples of services provided through the Home Care Program include grocery shopping/delivery, chore services, and personal hygiene assistance.



Eligibility

Eligibility for the Home Care Program is determined by need and based on age, residence, and ability to carry out daily tasks. Applicants for the Home Care Program must be living at home within Massachusetts and outside of an institutional or certified assisting living setting.

Cost

The cost of the Home Care services is based on income. Scan the QR to the right to view the cost share guidelines.
